## MERIT DECISIONS WITH OPINIONS

**2024-0405. In re Application of Daubenmire, Slip Opinion No. 2024-Ohio-2230.**

On Report by the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness, No. 877. Applicant Zachary Charles Daubenmire's pending registration application approved. Applicant permitted to sit for the July 2024 bar exam. Board's motion to supplement the board record granted.

DeWine, Donnelly, Stewart, Brunner, and Deters, JJ., concur.

Kennedy, C.J., and Fischer, J., dissent and would not allow Daubenmire to take the July 2024 bar exam.

**2024-0624. State ex rel. Gomez v. Favreau.**

Appellees' memorandum in response to jurisdiction remains due in accordance with this court's May 31, 2024 entry.

Cuyahoga App. Nos. 112214 and 113039, [2024-Ohio-1360](#). On appellant's motion for leave to file revised memorandum in support of jurisdiction. Motion granted. Appellant's revised memorandum in support of jurisdiction deemed filed as of the date of the court's entry.
