MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2024-0343. Martens v. Price.

Hancock App. No. 5-23-04, [2023-Ohio-4359](#). On appellant's motion for leave to file revised motion for reconsideration. Motion granted. Appellant's revised motion for reconsideration deemed filed as of the date of the court's entry.

2024-0474. State v. Brown.

Henry App. No. 7-23-05, [2024-Ohio-627](#). On appellant's motion to appoint the Office of the Ohio Public Defender as counsel. Motion granted. Office of the Ohio Public Defender appointed to represent appellant.

2024-0502. State v. Lawless.

Ashland App. No. 23COA012. Appellant's memorandum in support of jurisdiction fails to comply with S.Ct.Prac.R. 7.02(B) (a memorandum "shall not exceed fifteen numbered pages, exclusive of the table of contents and certificate of service"). Sua sponte, pages 16 through 18 of the memorandum in support of jurisdiction stricken.

2024-0608. Stubblefield v. Warden.

In Habeas Corpus. On petitioner's motion for citation. Motion denied as moot.

2024-0710. State ex rel. Pagani v. Krichbaum.

Mahoning App. No. 24 MA 0031, [2024-Ohio-1810](#). On motion for admission pro hac vice of Jonathan Andres. Motion granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days.

2024-0931. Wynn v. Crumm.

Hamilton App. No. C-230341, [2024-Ohio-1447](#). On appellee Beatrice Crumm's motion to strike. Motion granted. Memorandum in response to jurisdiction filed June 26, 2024, stricken.

2024-0939. State v. Addiego.

Henry App. No. 7-23-09, [2024-Ohio-1849](#). On motion for admission pro hac vice of Brian F. Russo. Motion granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2023-1293. State ex rel. Ware v. Booth.

In Mandamus. Relator has not filed a merit brief, due July 5, 2024, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

2024-0336. State ex rel. Howard v. Sackett.

In Mandamus. On relator's motion for referral to mediation. Motion denied. Relator has not filed a merit brief, due July 5, 2024, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

2024-0330. Bonds v. Lape.

In Mandamus. The court returns this case to the regular docket under S.Ct.Prac.R. 19.01. Respondents shall file a response to the complaint within 21 days.
