#### MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

# 2023-1327. State ex rel. Gatehouse Media Ohio Holdings II, Inc. v. Columbus Police Dept.

In Mandamus. On motion of amicus curiae Ohio Attorney General Dave Yost to participate in oral argument. Motion granted. Amicus curiae Ohio Attorney General Dave Yost shall share time allotted to respondent.

#### **2024-1455.** Thieret v. Pistorius.

In Mandamus and Quo Warranto. Sua sponte, relator ordered to show cause within 14 days why this cause should not be dismissed for failure to perfect service on respondent U-Haul Moving & Storage within the time period since the complaint was filed.

# 2024-1603. State ex rel. Yost v. Rover Pipeline, L.L.C.

Stark App. No. 2023CA00151, **2024-Ohio-4769**. On motions for admission pro hac vice of Matthew X. Etchemendy, Jason J. Fleischer, William Scherman, and Ronald J. Tenpas. Motions granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file notices of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days.

### 2024-1645. State ex rel. Howard v. Willamowski.

In Mandamus and Prohibition. On respondent Magistrate Michael Bear's motion to strike motion for leave to conduct limited discovery and motion for leave to plead / motion for an emergency writ. Motion denied. Sua sponte, respondents permitted to file a response to relator's motion for an emergency peremptory writ of mandamus and prohibition, motions for stay, and request for leave to conduct limited discovery within ten days from the date of the court's entry.

## 2024-0907. State ex rel. Mohican Young Star Academy v. Cornyn.

In Mandamus. On relator's application for dismissal. Application granted. Cause dismissed.

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
