1. Amendments to the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio (Gov.Bar R. XIV(1) through (8) and Appendices IV and VI) and the Ohio Rules of Professional Conduct (Prof.Cond.R. 7.4) were adopted on February 27, 2024, and are effective April 15, 2024. The final version of the amendments has been posted on the court's website and will be published in the March 18, 2024 Ohio Official Reports advance sheet.

2. Amendments to the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Judiciary of Ohio (Gov.Jud.R. II(5) and III(2)) were adopted on February 27, 2024, and are effective March 1, 2024.
