MERIT DECISIONS WITH OPINIONS

2024-0469. *State ex rel. Schwarzmer v. Mazzone*, Slip Opinion No. **2025-Ohio-1246**.

Cuyahoga App. No. 113319, **2024-Ohio-1050**. Judgment reversed.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2025-0285. *Wildcat Drilling, L.L.C. v. Discovery Oil & Gas, L.L.C.*

Mahoning App. Nos. 24MA0060 and 24MA0066, **2025-Ohio-1175**. On appellant's application for dismissal. Application granted. Cause dismissed.

2025-0319. *State ex rel. Lattimore v. Brown*.

Franklin App. No. 24AP-357. Appellant has not filed a merit brief, due April 10, 2025, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

MEDIATION MATTERS

2024-1637. *Straub Nissan, L.L.C. v. Harris*.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2022-422. The court returns this case to the regular docket under Rule 19.01. Appellant shall file a brief within 40 days, and the

parties shall otherwise proceed in accordance with Section 16 of the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio. As provided in Rule 16.07, the court may dismiss this case or take other action if the parties fail to timely file merit briefs.

2024-1789. State ex rel. Kent Elastomer Prods., Inc. v. Logue.

Franklin App. No. 21AP-387, [2024-Ohio-5451](#). The court returns this case to the regular docket under Rule 19.01. Appellant shall file a brief within 40 days, and the parties shall otherwise proceed in accordance with Section 16 of the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio. As provided in Rule 16.07, the court may dismiss this case or take other action if the parties fail to timely file merit briefs.

2025-0484. State ex rel. Standen v. N. Ridgeville.

In Mandamus. The court refers this case to mediation under Rule 19.01 and stays all filing deadlines for this case until further order of this court. The court will not issue any decision on the merits of this case until mediation has concluded.
