MERIT DECISIONS WITH OPINIONS

2024-0437. State ex rel. Clark v. Dept. of Rehab. & Corr., Slip Opinion No. 2025-Ohio-1577.

In Mandamus. On relator’s motion for leave to file rebuttal evidence. Motion granted as to proposed exhibit Nos. 3 and 4 and denied as to proposed exhibit Nos. 1, 2, and 2-E. Writ denied as moot with respect to the request for the “Legal Dockets” memorandum and denied outright with respect to all other requests. Relator’s requests for statutory damages and court costs denied.

DeWine, Deters, Hawkins, and Shanahan, JJ., concur.

Fischer, J., concurs in judgment only.

Kennedy, C.J., concurs in part and dissents in part, with an opinion.

Brunner, J., concurs in part and dissents in part and would grant the motion for leave in full.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2025-0163. State v. Kerns.

Lorain App. No. 24CA012138. Appellant has not filed a memorandum in support of jurisdiction, due May 1, 2025, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

2025-0548. State v. Reichelderfer.

Holmes App. No. 24CA009, **2025-Ohio-899**. Appellant has not filed a memorandum in support of jurisdiction, due May 1, 2025, in compliance with the

Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

MEDIATION MATTERS

2025-0572. State ex rel. Union Twp. Bd. of Trustees v. Hebron.

In Mandamus. The court refers this case to mediation under Rule 19.01 and stays all filing deadlines for this case until further order of this court. The court will not issue any decision on the merits of this case until mediation has concluded.
