MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2025-0060, 2025-0102, 2025-0103, 2025-0166, 2025-0170, 2025-0182, and 2025-0239. State ex rel. Cleavenger v. Melton.

In Mandamus. Relator has not filed a merit brief, due May 27, 2025, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute these causes with the requisite diligence. Causes dismissed.

2025-0335. State v. Hayes.

Montgomery App. No. 29987, **2024-Ohio-6046**. Appellant has not filed a memorandum in support of jurisdiction, due May 29, 2025, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

2025-0349. State ex rel. Boyd v. Tone.

2024-1128. State ex rel. Fed. Pub. Defender N. Dist. of Ohio v. Trumbull Cty. Prosecutor.

In Mandamus. Pursuant to R.C. 2710.06(B)(1), the court has been notified that the parties to this case have reached a settlement. The case is returned to the regular docket under Rule 19.01. Relator shall file either an application for dismissal or a notice of failure of settlement within 60 days. The case will be dismissed for want of prosecution if an application for dismissal or a notice of failure of settlement is not filed within 60 days.
