MERIT DECISIONS WITH OPINIONS

2024-0008. State ex rel. Mobley v. Grabman, Slip Opinion No. 2025-Ohio-2257.

In Mandamus. On relator's motion for leave to file rebuttal evidence. Motion denied. Writ denied as moot. Relator's requests for statutory damages and court costs denied.

Fischer, DeWine, Deters, Hawkins, and Shanahan, JJ., concur.

Kennedy, C.J., concurs in judgment only, with an opinion.

Brunner, J., concurs in part and dissents in part, with an opinion.

2025-0363. In re Application of Circleville Solar Facility, L.L.C.

Power Siting Board, No. 21-1090-EL-BGN. On motion for permission to appear pro hac vice of Luke A. Helms. Motion granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days.

2025-0620. In re Rev. of Duke Energy Ohio, Inc.'s Distrib. Capital Invest. Rider.

Public Utilities Commission, No. 23-549-EL-RDR. On Duke Energy Ohio, Inc.'s motion for leave to intervene as appellee. Motion granted.

2025-0856. Gozion v. Jarvela.

Cuyahoga App. No. 114684. Appellant’s memorandum in support of jurisdiction fails to comply with Rule 7.02(B)(1) (a memorandum “shall not exceed fifteen numbered pages, exclusive of the table of contents, the signature block, and the certificate of service”). Sua sponte, pages 16 through 22 of the memorandum in support of jurisdiction, exclusive of the signature block, stricken.
