MERIT DECISIONS WITH OPINIONS

2024-1712. State ex rel. Owens v. Gifford, Slip Opinion No. 2025-Ohio-2544. Richland App. No. 2024 CA 0020, **2024-Ohio-5468**. Judgment reversed and cause remanded.

MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

On requests for leave to proceed. Requests denied.

2024-0668. Bhamidipati v. Sylvania Twp. Police.

Miscellaneous case. Sua sponte, relator ordered to show cause within 14 days why this cause should not be dismissed pursuant to the July 11, 2025 decision of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, in *Bhamidipati v. Kaptur*, case No. 2:24-cv-3119.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2025-0468. State ex rel. Perry v. Inniss.

In Mandamus. Relator has not filed a merit brief, due July 18, 2025, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

MEDIATION MATTERS

2024-1569. Checkfree Servs. Corp. v. Harris.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2019-43. The court returns this case to the regular docket under Rule 19.01. Appellant shall file a merit brief within 40 days, and the parties shall otherwise proceed in accordance with Section 16 of the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio. As provided in Rule 16.07, the court may dismiss this case or take other action if the parties fail to timely file merit briefs.

2025-0677. State ex rel. Wasserman v. O'Shaughnessy.

In Mandamus. The court returns this case to the regular docket under Rule 19.01. Respondent shall file a response to the complaint within 21 days of the court's entry or within 21 days of service of the summons and complaint, whichever is later.
