2024-1068. State ex rel. Castellon v. Maloney, Slip Opinion No. 2025-Ohio-4867.

In Mandamus. Writ and relator's requests for statutory damages, court costs, and attorney's fees denied.

Brunner, J., concurs in part and concurs in judgment only as to Part II(A)(1).

# 2024-1203. State ex rel. Snodgrass v. Trumbull Corr. Inst., Slip Opinion No. 2025-Ohio-4688.

In Mandamus. On relator's motion to consider documents as evidence. Motion granted. Writ granted. Relator's request for statutory damages denied. Costs assessed to respondent in accordance with Rule 18.05.

Brunner, J., concurs in part and dissents in part and would award relator \$1,000 in statutory damages.
