MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

In re McCoy.

On February 2, 2024, this court found Charles McCoy to be a vexatious litigator under Rule 4.03(B) in *McCoy v. Gonzales-Wells*, [2024-Ohio-355](#), and *McCoy v. Land-Libby*, [2024-Ohio-355](#). On McCoy’s motion for leave. Motion granted. The clerk of the court shall file the motion for leave and “original action in mandamus complaint” as of October 15, 2025. McCoy shall submit the filing fee and security deposit as required by Rules 3.04 and 3.05, or an affidavit of indigence in accordance with Rule 3.06, within 14 days of the court’s entry.
