MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2025-1057. Columbus v. State.

Franklin App. No. 24AP-333, [2025-Ohio-2408](#). On motion for permission to appear pro hac vice of Selin Cherian-Rivers. Motion granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court’s Office of Attorney Services within 30 days.

2025-1658. State ex rel. McCormack v. Ashtabula Cty. Med. Ctr.

Franklin App. No. 24AP-270, [2025-Ohio-5151](#). On stipulated motion for an additional stay of briefing due to settlement. Motion granted. Briefing schedule stayed for 45 days from the date of the court’s entry.

2026-0081. Pryor v. Burkhart.

In Mandamus. On relator’s motion to strike. Motion denied. Sua sponte, relator permitted to file a response to respondent’s motion to dismiss within ten days of the court’s entry. Relator’s “motion to strike - motion to dismiss” denied as moot.

2026-0228. Kane v. Kane.

Warren App. No. CA2025-03-020, [2026-Ohio-73](#). On appellant’s motion for leave to file revised memorandum in support of jurisdiction. Motion granted. Appellant’s revised memorandum deemed filed as of the date of the court’s entry.

2026-0335. State v. Christian.

Franklin App. Nos. 23AP-677 through 23AP-679, [2026-Ohio-365](#). Appellant’s memorandum in support of jurisdiction fails to comply with Rule 7.02(B)(1) (a memorandum “shall not exceed fifteen numbered pages, exclusive of the table of

contents, the signature block, and the certificate of service”). Sua sponte, pages 16 through 37 of the memorandum in support of jurisdiction, exclusive of the signature block, stricken.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2026-0275. State ex rel. Fenstermaker v. Delaware Cty. Sheriff Dept.
In Mandamus. On relator’s application for dismissal. Application granted. Cause dismissed.
