2019-0500. Columbus Bar Assn. v. Armengau.

Sua sponte, Javier Horacio Armengau, Attorney Registration No. 0069776, last known business address in Columbus, Ohio, found in contempt for failure to surrender his certificate of admission and failure to file an affidavit of compliance on or before May 8, 2026.

2026-0398. State v. Lott.

Cuyahoga App. No. 114992, [2026-Ohio-555](#). On appellant's application for dismissal. Application granted. Cause dismissed.

MEDIATION MATTERS

2025-0820. Akron v. Harris.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2022-282. Appellant shall either file an application for dismissal of this case or a notice of failure of settlement within 60 days. This case will be dismissed for want of prosecution if an application for dismissal or notice of failure of settlement is not filed within 60 days.

2025-1019. The Pointe at Polaris Phase I, L.L.C. v. Harris.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2022-463. Appellant shall file either an application for dismissal of this case or a merit brief in accordance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio within 60 days. This case will be dismissed for want of prosecution if an application for dismissal or merit brief is not filed within 60 days.
