MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2026-0103. Arndts v. Univ. of Cincinnati Dept. of Pub. Safety.

Franklin App. No. 25AP-355, [2025-Ohio-5648](#). Appellant’s memorandum in support of jurisdiction fails to comply with Rule 7.02(B)(1) (a memorandum “shall not exceed fifteen numbered pages, exclusive of the table of contents, the signature block, and the certificate of service”). Sua sponte, pages 17 through 20 of the memorandum in support of jurisdiction, exclusive of the signature block, stricken.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2025-1377. State ex rel. Bradford v. Zayas.

In Procedendo. On relator’s application for dismissal. Application granted. Respondents’ motion to dismiss amended complaint denied as moot. Cause dismissed.

2025-1623. State ex rel. Reyes v. Dept. of Rehab. & Corr.

In Mandamus. On relator’s application for dismissal. Application granted. Respondents’ motion to dismiss denied as moot. Cause dismissed.

MEDIATION MATTERS

2025-1019. The Pointe at Polaris Phase I, L.L.C. v. Harris.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2022-463. Pursuant to R.C. 2710.06(B)(1), the court has been notified that the parties to this case have reached a settlement. The case is

returned to the regular docket under S.Ct.Prac.R. 19.01. Appellant shall file either an application for dismissal or a merit brief within 60 days. The case will be dismissed for want of prosecution if an application for dismissal or a merit brief is not filed within 60 days.
