MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2026-0710. Klopfenstein v. Fifth Third Bank.

Certified Question of State Law, United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, Nos. 24-3955 and 24-3974. On motion for permission to appear pro hac vice of Robert M. Devling. Motion granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days.

Portage App. No. 2025-P-0029, **2026-Ohio-973**. On appellee's motion to strike appellant's motion for delayed appeal. Motion denied as moot.

2026-0824. State v. Hunter.

Summit App. No. 31691, **2026-Ohio-1744**. On appellant's motion for leave to file revised memorandum in support of jurisdiction. Motion granted. Appellant's revised memorandum in support of jurisdiction deemed filed as of the date of the court's entry.
