MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

In re Williams.

On August 19, 2026, this court found Michael A. Williams Sr. to be a vexatious litigator under Rule 4.03(B) in **2026-0637**, *State ex rel. Williams v. Lorain Cty. On Williams’ “renewed and supplemental application for leave; request for reconsideration, clarification, or narrowing of S.Ct.Prac.R. 4.03(B) filing restrictions; request for identification of the decisional basis supporting the August 19, 2026 determination; and preservation of objections,” “motion for limited leave under S.Ct.Prac.R. 4.03(B) to file second, corrected Rule 4.04 request and supporting affidavit,” “renewed and supplemental application for leave to file corrected memorandum in opposition to the August 21, 2026 motion to dismiss; request to cure S.Ct.Prac.R. 12.02 affidavit defect; and notice of protective procedural compliance without concession or waiver,” and “renewed and supplemental application for leave to continue pending original action and to file memorandum in opposition to respondents’ August 21, 2026 motion to dismiss; request for case-specific review; and notice of protective procedural

compliance without concession or waiver.” Applications for leave and motion for limited leave denied.
