Sup.R. 36.20(A) Standard 12. Effectiveness Evaluation

A specialized docket judge shall evaluate the effectiveness of the specialized docket by doing each of the following:

- (A) Reporting data as required by the Supreme Court, including information to assess compliance with these standards;
- (B) Engaging in on-going data collection in order to evaluate whether the specialized docket is meeting its goals and objectives.

Evaluation 101



- Why are we doing what we are doing?
- Are we doing what we said we would do?
- Are doing it in a quality way?
- Is it making a difference?

Multi-Purpose Data



- **Inform policy** – Learn what works and what doesn't
- **Support operations** – Monitor, evaluate, report, plan, budget
- **Educate the public** – Tell our story

Standard 12 Reporting Process



- Data collection started July 1, 2019
- Data collected:
 - Referrals, referral process, and outcomes
 - Participants, participation process, outcomes
- Reports required at least once a month, but no later than the 15th of the month following the month with activity
- Validation checks and error messages









Race and Opioid Use



Age and Opioid Use







- Time between **Risk Assessment Date** and **Date Accepted or Rejected from Docket**
- Time between **Initial Clinical Assessment Referred Date** and **Initial Clinical Assessment Completed Date**
- “No” selected under all **Funding Source** categories
- Same date entered for **Initial Treatment Start Date** and **Initial Treatment End Date**

Performance Measures



- **Graduation Rate** – Percentage of participants exiting a docket over a specific time period who graduated from the docket.
- **Retention Rate** – Percentage of participants who remained in the docket at defined intervals from admission (e.g., 6 months and 12 months).
- **In-Program Recidivism Rate** – Percentage of participants exiting a docket over a specific time period who had a new criminal charge *while participating in the docket*.
- **Post-Exit Recidivism Rate** – Percentage of participants graduating from a docket over a specific time period who had a new criminal charge *after exiting the docket*.

- **Timeliness Measures**

- Days between Referral and Acceptance Determination
- Days between Treatment Start and Treatment Exit
- Days between Acceptance and Exit
